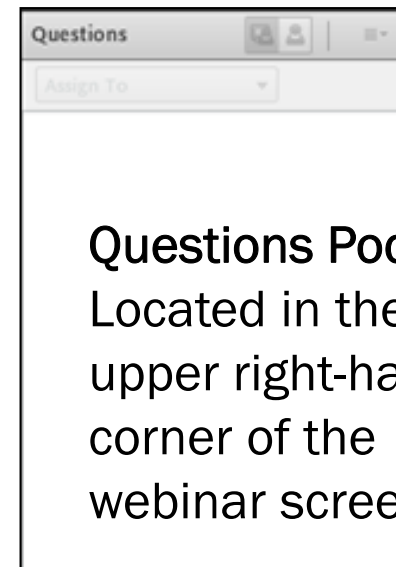

SEVIS Enhancements vs. SEVIS II

- SEVP Director Farrell's SEVIS Enhancements video at <http://studyinthestates.dhs.gov/2014/03/sevis-way-ahead>
- DHS to improve SEVIS to address national security concerns
- Thirty-five new functionalities identified
- Supplemental contracts added personnel to increase project resources

Vulnerabilities that cannot be addressed in SEVIS will be analyzed for alternatives.

Form I-17 Conversion

- Only two existing fields on Form I-17 are affected by the conversion:
 - **Field 10:** The school operates under the following federal, state, local, or other authorization
 - **Field 11:** The school has been approved by the following national, regional, or state accrediting association or agency

SEVP will provide detailed guidance to assist schools with the conversion.

Spring 2014 Release

- Form I-17 data conversion project
- Corrects a national security vulnerability
- Provides:
 - **Data standardization and accuracy**
 - **Ease of input**
 - **Comprehensive list of agencies**
 - **Allows complete input of names**

Summer 2014 Release

- OPT dates and flags
- CAP Gap indicator
- DSO validation
- Status changes of level and transfer
- Geographical designations
- Name standards
- CIP code groups
- History updates
- Dirty data
- Program end dates and completions
- E-mail and address validation
- Update validation alert (DoS)

Name Standards

- Family/Primary Name
- First/Given Name
- Middle Name
- Suffix
- Indicator that a person has no name other than the Family/Primary Name
- Passport Name
- Preferred Name

Name Standards

- Family/Primary Name, First/Given Name, and Middle Name fields:
 - Latin alphabet, no hyphen, no apostrophe
 - One space between names
 - No: LNU, FNU, Unknown, Not Applicable
 - UNK, NA – requires confirmation of name

SEVIS will impose a universal standard of naming conventions, so names are entered consistently.
