FMJ Fee Payment Update

SEVP has enhanced and streamlined the [I-901 SEVIS fee payment process](#) on [FJMfee.com](#). SEVP recently automated Western Union fee payment processing and developed an I-901 SEVIS fee payment tutorial to inform stakeholders about the payment process.

In addition, SEVP is excited to announce the launch of a mobile-friendly FMJfee.com website. Users can now log into the site on any mobile device to:

- Find recent news and updates related to the I-901 SEVIS fee;
- Check an I-901 SEVIS fee payment status;
- View, save and print an I-901 payment confirmation;
- Read answers to frequently asked questions; and
- Visit [Study in the States](#) and associated social media platforms.

Those who have paid the fee must still print a copy of their I-901 SEVIS fee payment confirmation to take with them when applying for a visa to enter the United States. Please note the copy shown from a mobile device will not be accepted. Stay tuned for additional updates and enhancements to the mobile site, including mobile I-901 SEVIS fee payment capabilities.
