I-901 Fee Payment Process Update

Regulation requires F and M nonimmigrant students to pay the I-901 Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) fee before applying for a student visa from the U.S. Department of State. SEVP is streamlining the payment process for students and exchange visitors using Western Union to pay their I-901 fee. Effective April 15, F and M students and J-1 exchange visitors will have to complete the Form I-901 on FMJFee.com before going to a Western Union location to pay the I-901 fee. Completing the form will generate a unique coupon number needed to validate and process the Western Union payment. If a third party pays the I-901 SEVIS fee on the student's behalf, the student will need to provide them with the coupon number to make the Western Union payment. SEVP changed this process to allow for the real-time posting of Western Union payments and to permit students to immediately print their I-901 payment confirmation.
