Interim Final Policy Guidance

Evidence for Schools Not Meeting Eligibility Criteria

Overview

- Clarifies acceptable evidence for schools that do not meet eligibility criteria defined in federal regulation
- Comment period closed Dec. 12, 2016
 - SEVP officials will review stakeholder comments
 - Schools expected to adhere to guidance


