Completing the Annual SEVIS Verification

March 2, 2017 marked the end of the annual SEVIS verification period. As of that date, 98 percent of school or program officials in SEVIS have been verified. If you are a principal designated school official (PDSO) who has not yet completed your school's SEVIS verification, please do so immediately.

Any SEVIS user who is not verified will remain locked out of the system until their PDSO complies.
