Remind Post-Completion OPT Students to be Prepared for the SEVP Portal

In December 2016, the Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) will launch the SEVP Portal for F-1 students participating in post-completion optional practical training (OPT). Through the portal, these students will be able to add or edit their:

- Phone number
- Mailing and physical address
- Employer information

An important note: Students participating in a science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) OPT extension will not be able to add or edit employer information through the SEVP Portal when it is released in December. Regulations require designated school officials (DSOs) to verify completeness of the Form I-983, "Training Plan for STEM OPT Students," which includes employer information, and to retain the form in the student's record. For more information about a DSO's role and the Form I-983, please visit Study in the States.

To prepare for the portal's launch, post-completion OPT students must confirm with their DSO that their personal email address is up to date. To assist stakeholders with understanding the SEVP Portal and student reporting requirements, a new Student Data Integrity section will be added to Study in the States in November 2016. Finally, mark your calendar for the SEVP Special Report Webinar: SEVP Portal on Nov. 17, 2016. This webinar, designed for DSOs and F-1

students on post-completion OPT, will provide important information about the SEVP Portal.
