began on Dec. 2, 2015. SEVP encourages PDSOs to complete this required verification of all DSOs in the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) as soon as possible. Failure to complete verification by the March 2, 2016 deadline will result in loss of SEVIS access for all DSOs at a school.
