





Effective Dates

Regulatory Requirement

Takes effect on May 10, 2016.

SEVIS Change

- May 13, 2016 Release focuses on ability to generate documentation needed for STEM
- More changes to come in future releases





Timing of May 13, 2016 Release

- Already had a release scheduled to improve SEVIS data sharing with other government systems
- Could not reschedule that release
- Could not deploy two releases within three days





Change: Longer Period of STEM

Regulatory Requirement

17-month STEM OPT becomes 24-month period.

SEVIS Change

- Quick, easy change
- SEVIS will calculate
 STEM OPT validity period
 of 24 months
- Effective May 13, 2016
- Demonstration and a closer look at this follows





Change: Form I-983, Training Plan for STEM OPT Student

Regulatory Requirement

Collect Form I-983, Training Plan for STEM OPT Students.

SEVIS Change

Short Term

Not able to add this for May 13, 2016 Release.

Workaround: Enter comment into the "Explain how employment is related to student's course of study" field:

I have reviewed the Form I-983. It is completed, signed, and addresses all program requirements.





Change: Form I-983, Training Plan for STEM OPT Student

Regulatory Requirement

Collect Form I-983, Training Plan for STEM OPT Students. (continued)

SEVIS Change

Mid Term

Add check box/attestation for receipt of Form I-983.

Longer Term

Capture Form I-983 information electronically.





Change: Prior Degree

Regulatory Requirement

Allow STEM Extension based on prior degree.

SEVIS Change

Short Term

- Unable to add fields in SEVIS to collect this information by May 13, 2016
- Display link to extend on all records with post-completion OPT





Change: Prior Degree

Regulatory Requirement

Allow STEM Extension based on prior degree. (continued)

SEVIS Change

Workaround: Enter comment into the "Explain how employment is related to student's course of study" field:

Extension based on prior STEM degree: (Enter information on: qualifying major, qualifying degree level, Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) code, date of degree, school awarding degree, school location, awarding school code, if available, and class of admission at time of degree.)





Change: Prior Degree

Regulatory Requirement

Allow STEM Extension based on prior degree. (continued)

SEVIS Change

Long Term

Determine how best to capture and display information on prior degree.





Change: Second Period of STEM OPT

Regulatory Requirement

Allow student to have a second period of STEM OPT at higher level.

SEVIS Change

In the May 13, 2016 Release, DSOs can recommend second period of STEM OPT.

Long Term

Cap number of STEM extensions at two per student.





Change: Student Validation Reporting

Regulatory Requirement

6-month interval validation reporting.

SEVIS Change

- Extend existing 6-month validations to cover the entire 24-month period of STEM OPT
- SEVIS release in late summer/early fall 2016





Change: Student Progress Evaluations

Regulatory Requirement

- Student and employer self-evaluations due:
 - 12 months after STEM
 OPT authorization starts
 - When leave employer
 - When complete STEM
 OPT (final evaluation)
- System Termination for failure to complete
 12-month self-evaluation

SEVIS Change

Not able to add this to the May 13, 2016 Release.

Mid Term

- Determine how to capture and display this information
- Determine if/when to terminate, if student fails to comply





Change: Change of Employer

Regulatory Requirement

Student must provide DSO with a completed Form I-983 for new employer within 10 days of start date with employer.

SEVIS Change

Short Term

Use workaround language to capture receipt of Form I-983.

Longer Term

Need to determine how best to implement the 10-day deadline.





Change: Increased Period of Unemployment

Regulatory Requirement

Number of days of unemployment increased from 120 to 150.

SEVIS Change

Short Term

- Not able to add this to the May 13, 2016 Release
- Modify System termination job to allow 150 days of unemployment

Note: System termination job is NOT currently running.





Change: Increased Period of Unemployment

Regulatory Requirement

Number of days of unemployment increased from 120 to 150. (continued)

SEVIS Change

Long Term

Create unemployment counter to count aggregate days of unemployment.





Change: Increased Filing Deadline

Regulatory Requirement

Filing deadline based on the date the DSO recommended STEM OPT increased from 30 to 60 days.

SEVIS Change

- No modification of SEVIS required
- USCIS will determine whether student has met the deadline





Change: Conversion of Pending 17-Month OPT Requests

Regulatory Requirement

In response to USCIS
Request For Evidence
(RFE), DSOs must generate
a Form I-20 with a 24-month
recommendation for STEM
OPT.

SEVIS Change

- Effective May 13, 2016
- DSOs will be able to convert a 17-month STEM OPT request, if the status of the request in SEVIS is:
 - Requested
 - Pending
- More detailed discussion of this follows





Change: 7-Month Extension of Approved 17-Month OPT

Regulatory Requirement

- DSOs can recommend a 7-month extension of approved STEM OPT, if student has at least 150 days left on STEM OPT
- Filing period: May 10 through August 8, 2016

SEVIS Change

- Effective May 13, 2016
- Link to Extend STEM OPT will display on records with:
 - Approved STEM OPT
 - STEM OPT expiration dates on or after October 7, 2016
- More detailed discussion of this follows





Change: 7-Month Extension of Approved 17-Month OPT

Regulatory Requirement

Student Portal

SEVIS Change

Not able to add this for May 13, 2016 Release.

Long Term

Create a portal that is a SEVIS subsystem.

24-Month Extensions for STEM OPT

- DSOs will be able to recommend 24-month STEM OPT extensions
- SEVIS will calculate the start and end dates
- DSOs must have the Form I-983 before recommending 24-month STEM OPT

- Describe how position relates to student's course of study (refer to Form I-983, Section 5, Student Role) per pre-webinar conversation with USCIS as of 4/29/2016 – not required for STEM cases since information is on the I-983
- Provide workaround text for Form I-983 and prior degree (see next slide)
- Does NOT print on Form I-20





Workaround Language: Form I-983

I have reviewed the Form I-983. It is completed, signed, and addresses all program requirements.





Workaround Language: Prior Degree

Extension based on prior STEM degree, enter information on:

- Qualifying major
- Qualifying degree level
- Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) code
- Date of degree
- School awarding degree
- School location
- Awarding school code, if available
- Class of admission at time of degree





STEM Recommendation Based on Prior Degree

Highly recommend sending transcripts with Form I-765.





Employer Information

- EIN is required for STEM OPT (available on the Form I-983)
- Employer Address enter site location from the Form I-983, Section 5
- Supervisor Information required for STEM OPT:
 - Name
 - Telephone number
 - Email address

(available on the Form I-983, Section 5)






Conversion of Pending 17-Month STEM OPT Recommendations

- Wait for RFE from USCIS before converting the case
- USCIS will identify pending cases
- SEVIS displays link to convert 17-month STEM recommendations in Requested or Pending status





Convert Requested/Pending 17-Month STEM OPT Extension




SEVIS displays link for RFE for students with STEM OPT extensions in Requested or Pending status on May 13, 2016.





Convert Requested/Pending 17-Month STEM OPT Extension - Attestation




DSO must agree to the attestation by clicking **Submit**.



Conversion of STEM OPT Request: As It Appears in Event History







7-Month Extension of Approved STEM OPT

- Link to extend STEM OPT displays only on records with STEM OPT end dates on or after October 7, 2016
- DSO must receive Form I-983 before recommending the 7-month extension in SEVIS
- Student must:
 - File Form I-765 with USCIS before the deadline
 - Must send Form I-20 with the 7-month recommendation

(exception to this rule discussed on next slide)





7-Month Extension of Approved STEM OPT Special Case

Special Case

Special filing instructions for people who must file Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization, with USCIS *before* May 23, 2016.

USCIS

- File Form I-765 with filing fee, but without the Form I-20 recommending extension
- USCIS will send an RFE for the Form I-20
- Student must meet regulatory filing deadline
- Students with filing deadline of May 23, 2016 or later *must* have Form I-20 with the recommendation





Required Statement from Students Who Must File ON or BETWEEN May 10-22, 2016

In cover letter, indicate:

"Due to new regulations, I must apply for the seven-month extension of my STEM OPT before SEVIS supports it. I will send a Form I-20 with the extension recommendation after USCIS requests it."








