Release Planning



Release Planning

- Date of Release: June 26, 2015
- System Outage:
 - From: Friday, June 26, 2015 at 8 PM
 - To: Sunday, June 28, 2015 at 8 PM
- Best to plan for system unavailability on Monday, June 29, 2015.



Systems Affected

Process/System	Effects
I-901 (SEVIS) Fee	The I-901 System will not be able to process the SEVIS fee payments. Students and exchange visitors must either pay ahead of time or wait until SEVIS is online again.
Social Security Numbers (SSN)	The Social Security Administration will not be able to confirm F, M, or J status for anyone. Those needing an SSN should either apply before the outage or wait until SEVIS is online again.
SAVE	SAVE agents will not be able to verify the F, M, or J status for anyone. Verification requests should either be submitted before the outage or after SEVIS is online again.

Systems Affected

Process/System	Effects
E-Verify	E-Verify will not be able to confirm the status of anyone in F, M, or J status. Employers should verify those employees before the outage or wait until SEVIS is online again.
Visa Applications	Consular officers at U.S. embassies and consulates can view SEVIS data in their own system. However, the data might not be up-to-date. Some visa applications may be delayed until the data feed from SEVIS is restored.
Ports of Entry	Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Officers can verify admissibility using information that is not up-to-date. Anyone seeking F, M, or J status may be sent to secondary inspection for processing. CBP Officers in secondary inspection cannot access SEVIS to verify F, J, or M nonimmigrants' SEVIS status.



Systems Affected

Process/System	Effects
State Departments of Motor Vehicles (DMV)	DMV Agents will not be able to use SAVE to verify the F, M, or J status of applicants for driver's licenses or state IDs. Nonimmigrants needing a state driver's licenses/ID card should either apply before the outage or wait until SEVIS is online again.

Critical Date/Time	What Happens
NOON (EST) Friday, June 26, 2015	Deadline for schools/ sponsors to upload batches to SEVIS.
2:00 PM (EST) Friday, June 26, 2015	SEVIS will process uploaded batches.
3:00 – 7:30 PM (EST) Friday, June 26, 2015	Transaction logs and PDFs of forms available for download.

Review of SEVIS Name Standards



Name Standards

- Latin alphabet, no hyphens, no apostrophes
- One space between names
- LNU, FNU, Unknown, Not Applicable will not be accepted
- Entry of UNK or NA requires confirmation of name

SEVIS will require a universal standard of naming conventions, so names are entered consistently.

On-Screen Help on Names

Visa Type: J-1

The Surname/Primary Name is required. If the person has only one name, use this field. Do not use any special characters. Only letters A to Z and spaces are allowed. Do not use an abbreviation such as FNU to indicate a name is unknown. See Help for more information

1. * **Surname/Primary Name**

Use this field for names other than the Surname/Primary names such as first and middle names. If the person has only one name, this field may be left blank. Do not use any special characters. Only letters A to Z and spaces are allowed. Do not use an abbreviation such as FNU to indicate a name is unknown. See Help for more information

2. **Given Name**

3. **Suffix:**

Select One ▼

Passport Name is optional but highly recommended. Enter the names found in the machine readable section of the passport, leaving out the separator character "<". Enter them in the order shown on the passport. See Help for more information.

4. **Passport Name**

This field allows names to be written in the order preferred in the person's home country. It may contain letters with diacritical markings such as Ä or Ñ. It may also contain hyphens, apostrophes, and a comma before the suffix. If you do not enter a Preferred Name, SEVIS will automatically enter the given name, surname/primary name, and a suffix, if applicable. See Help for more information

Important Points about Mass Reprint Requests

Mass Reprint

- Reprint forms for multiple people at one time with the same reprint reason.
- Cannot reprint a form for anyone who has had a form printed within the previous seven days.
- Forms are not immediately available.

New Form I-20

- June 26, 2015: New version available in SEVIS
- Current version of Form I-20 remains usable through July 1, 2016



July 1, 2016: All F/M students and dependents need the new version of Form I-20.

Form I-20 Changes

- Rebranding
- Elimination of barcode and spaces for visa and port of entry information
- Easier to read, cleaner layout
- Includes all name fields
- Instructions moved to page three
- Better separation of dependent information from student information
